

# Commvault's 'Hockey Helping Kids' Program Opens 15th Season Helping to Raise Public Awareness, Funds for Children's Charities

Each event features a JV game in which partners and customers face off against each other on NHL ice, the featured NHL Hockey match up at each venue, and a Varsity game in which CommVault's Employee Hockey Team plays against another team that usually consists of celebrated Olympic and NHL veteran players.

"Fifteen years of passionate Hockey Helping Kids team spirit has enabled our employees to partner with others in our industry and in the communities we serve to support organizations that help disadvantaged youth," said N. - Thursday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> Xcel Energy Center, St. Paul, MN, Wild vs. Rangers (supports Autism Society of Minnesota and Hendrickson's Foundation for Special Hockey)
